

OMIG Exclusion Search Tips

-Please enter the last name of the person you wish to search followed by the first name with a space in-between. Do not include any middle name, prefix, suffix or commas. Example: "Smith John"

-If a person has a hyphen in the last name, please do two searches, one with the hyphen and one without. This will increase the chance of finding an excluded individual.

-If a person has a space in the last name, please do two searches, one with the space and one without. Example: "McNamara" and "Mc Namara" or "MacNamara" or "Mac Namara." This will increase the chance of finding an excluded individual.

-Please note the results returned from your search are only possible matches. You do not need to verify all of these results, only the results you feel are a match for the name that you have entered. Example: If you search for "Lin John," you will receive "Bolling John" as a result. There is no need to verify the SSN match unless you feel "John Bolling" is the same person as "John Lin."

-Please keep in mind some of the people on the list might change their names to avoid detection. For example, a person can change their name when he or she gets married. "Aleksandr" may start going by "Alexander" or "Joseph" might be "Joe."
